

Palisades Trail Map Available

The Guide includes not only the trail map, it boldly states that the Park, as a Conservancy Area and City Park, is non-motorized! There is a brief description of the geology of Palisades that was described by geologist Mike Miller. The Area Etiquette section encourages a Leave No Trace ethic in using the Park. There is also a brief history of Park beginnings.

The production of the guide was a concerted volunteer effort from those who walked each trail with a GPS, and coordinated them on the map, to Northern Capital Management, who printed them, to Ben Johnson's Eagle Scout Project Troop 325, who constructed and hung the numbered trail signs on all the trails.

The trail signs are color coordinated to match the map. Spur trail signs are yellow, Loop trails are red going North and green going South. Cutoff trails are blue.

Enjoy Palisades Park and LEAVE NO TRACE! Especially do not tie plastic ribbons to trees and bushes! Stay on marked and established trails, leave the rest for the wildlife.
