

THIRTY ACRES ADDED TO PALISADES

It took 12 years of cooperative effort from Palisades, Spokane County Parks Conservation Futures and the Park Department of the City of Spokane to make it happen! We now have an additional 30 acres on the North end of Palisades adjoining the Baker Property.

This is part of the Gusman property that was proposed for the Conservation Futures program those long 12 years ago. This acquisition includes much of what is locally known as Crater Rocks or Snake Rocks. This particular section contains a totally different ecosystem than most of the surrounding area. The new property also includes wetlands, pine forests and a gorgeous meadow. Many of the Palisades wildlife residents use this area.
